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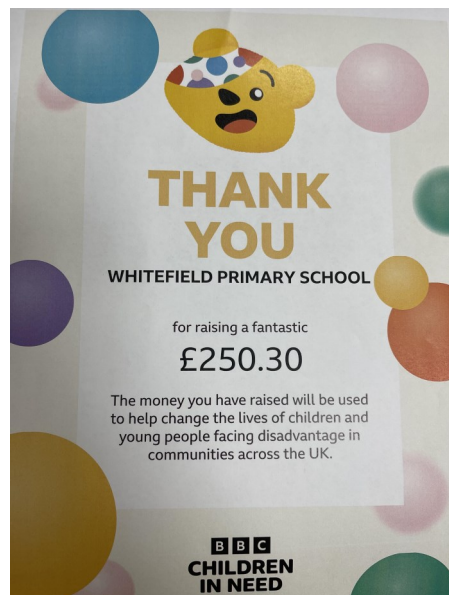
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ASSEMBLY THEMES:

PARKING AND DRIVING AROUND OUR SCHOOL:

Thank you to everyone who has been emailing us incidents of dangerous parking around our school.

A few reminders for those who continue to cause a safety issue for our children:

1. The cones outside school mean do not park here - and do not park in between them. Even though we do not have double yellow lines, parking in these areas is not safe.
2. The main gate is not a drop off point nor should it be used for three point turns - this is extremely dangerous as many of our families are walking across this area.
3. Drive at a safe speed around our school. It is a 20mph zone but at drop off and pick up times, you will need to be slower than this so you can be alert to dangers.
